KEA Educational Provision, week beginning 23 March 2020

You have identified that you require your son to have a place at our Educational Provision at Aston from the week beginning 23 March 2020. I am writing to confirm this booking and to outline the details of this arrangement.

Pupils attending the KEA Educational Provision will follow this timetable and adhere to the expectations outlined below:

- Only those booked into the educational provision can attend. Please email edprovision@keaston.bham.sch.uk if your son's circumstances change.
- Pupils must arrive at school by 8.40am and register in the school dining hall by 8.45am daily.
- Pupils are not required to wear school uniform.
- Pupils will be able to purchase a lunch from the school canteen as usual. Options will be limited and food choices made in advance. Free school meals available for those who are eligible.
- All pupils must bring their PE kit daily as they will have a games lesson after lunch.
- Pupils are expected to provide their own equipment such as pencil cases, calculators and resources.
- Mobile phones are permitted, however the use of phones is at the discretion of the supervising teachers.
- Pupils will only be able to access the following areas of school: East wing downstairs, the dining
 hall, sports hall, reception and outside areas. All other areas of the school will be out of bounds for
 deep cleaning.

- A first aider will be on duty daily


The educational provision has been set up in order to provide support for keyworkers' children and vulnerable pupils; it is important to note that if it is at all possible for children to be at home, then they should be.
