Guidance on acceptable footwear

As a school we have always had high expectations of students' uniform. Our uniform policy specifies that all students must wear black school shoes only. There is some guidance below to help you choose the correct footwear for your son.

Examples of acceptable footwear:

- Black leather/equivalent material
 - Laces or slip on (no Velcro)
 - Polishable



Examples of unacceptable footwear:

- No boots/shoes above ankle height
 - No logos or coloured stitching
- No sports brands e.g. Nike, Reebok etc.
 - No Velcro
- No trainers or trainer-style shoes



Please note:

Please do not hesitate to contact your child's Form Tutor/Head of Year/Pastoral Lead for further advice if necessary. The school retains the right to determine what footwear is acceptable.

Any student arriving to school in incorrect footwear will be sanctioned in line with our behaviour policy. This may include: provision of a suitable pair of black shoes to wear, removal from lessons/break or being sent home to return in suitable footwear.
