Please note the following important developments: -

### 1. **Car parking**

From Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> November 2017 parents who come to collect their son at the end of school will be able to use the Mosque car park on the corner of Albert Road and Upper Sutton Street free of charge. The car park will be open for use from 3.15pm-4.00pm with a member of the school's staff on duty.

There are 40 places which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Parents can park their car and walk to the school to meet their son at the Frederick Road gate or meet their son at the car park.

It is hoped that parents who currently park in Upper Thomas Street, along Albert Road or on Frederick Road will make use of this opportunity and in doing so reduce the congestion on the roads surrounding the school.

### 2. **Green Bus service to and from Aston railway station**

From Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> November 2017 the 843 Green Bus Service will stop at Aston railway station. In the morning the bus will pick up on Grosvenor Road (at the side of the station but opposite it) at around 7.55am. In the evening the bus will leave the school at 4.00pm reaching the station at 4.10pm dropping off in Grosvenor Road next to the station.

For the first week of operation The Green Bus will not charge for this service. From 13<sup>th</sup> November 2017 there will be a fare of £1.00 single between the station and the school. The Green Bus services do not take cash and a "Pay as You Go" PAYG Swift Card (a top up card valid on all buses in the West Midlands) will be needed. Only PAYG Swift Cards will be accepted-other forms of Swift Card or other travel cards and passes will not be valid.
