### **YEAR 7 INDUCTION DAY - WEDNESDAY 5<sup>th</sup> JULY 2017**

We will be holding an induction day to welcome our new Year 7 intake on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July; we hope that all of the boys joining us in September will be able to attend.

The aim of the day is to familiarise the boys with the school in order to make the start of term go as smoothly as possible.

The boys will spend the day meeting and mixing with their classmates. They will also spend some time with their form tutors and meet some of students in important roles within the school, such as the School Captain. The day will be organised in such a way that the boys will learn something of the physical layout of the school, the way the school day is structured and some of the school's routines.

The day will commence at **9.15am** - boys should be brought to the gate leading onto the upper playground in Upper Thomas Street (at the top of Albert Road) shortly before that time where they should assemble. The day will end at **3.00pm** - when they will need to be collected from the upper playground.

Your son is entitled to a **free** 'meal of the day' on induction day. Meat (including Halal) or vegetarian options will be available. If your son does not want a school dinner, please provide him with a packed lunch. They should dress in 'smart/casual' clothes - not school uniforms – and should bring **basic writing materials** with them.

It would be most helpful if boys could bring a cheque for around £20 (**made payable to Alliance in Partnership**) to be credited to their school lunch account. If you think your son is entitled to free school meals you will need to complete the appropriate forms and return them to school. If you are uncertain if your son is entitled to receive free school meals, please do not hesitate to contact the Student Services department at [b.ward@keaston.bham.sch.uk](mailto:b.ward@keaston.bham.sch.uk) or on 0121 327 1130. This will enable our lunchtime arrangements to operate efficiently in September 2017.

We hope this will be an enjoyable and interesting day that will go a long way towards preparing the boys for the transfer to Aston in September.
