### Appointment of a teacher of Personal, Social & Health Education

#### Information for applicants

- i. This is a new, permanent, part-time appointment, effective from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 for 0.40-0.60fte (2 or 3 days per week) with a salary payable on the main professional (M1-M6) or upper (UPS1-3) pay scales.
- ii. The successful applicant will be required to teach Personal, Social & Health Education to classes in Years 7-11 and may be asked to contribute to the programme in Years 12 & 13. In addition you will be required to share a tutor group with another colleague delivering their fortnightly form tutor period.
- iii. The successful candidate will work closely with the Assistant Head Teacher who has cluster responsibility for Personal, Social & Health Education in the development, delivery & evaluation of the curriculum.
- iv. We are looking to appoint an enthusiastic and committed and reflective teacher of Personal, Social & Health Education with clear ideas on how the subject should be delivered. The successful applicant will have experience of teaching in the subject to boys aged 11-16 although experience of teaching in a selective school environment is not required.
- v. The school takes its responsibility for the safety of the students extremely seriously and applicants will be expected to demonstrate a clear understanding of their responsibilities in this area at all stages of the application process.
- vi. If you wish to apply for the position please complete an application form (available from the web site) as well as a covering letter (word processed, no more than two sides of A4, font size twelve) explaining why your experience to date makes you suitable for the position. Referees must be able to comment on your ability as a teacher and must include the Head Teacher of the last school or institution in which you were employed except in the case of applicants still in training when one of the two references must be from the course tutor.
