Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

Given the current level of your family income your son is entitled to receive free school meals. This means that each day your son's school catering account will be credited with £2.30 to spend in the school dining hall.

In addition he will be eligible to receive the 16-19 Bursary. For the 2018-2019 academic year this has a value of £1,000 and can be spent as follows

- i. The cost of a travel pass e.g. Green Bus, West Midlands Travel etc.
- ii. The cost of school uniform as set out in the school's uniform policy, including Games & PE kit. Please send receipts as proof of purchase to Mrs Piper in order to claim your refund.
- iii. The cost of purchasing materials required in the study of any A-Level subjects. Please send receipts as proof of purchase to Mrs Piper in order to claim your refund.
- iv. The costs of extra-curricular visits including residential activities and those taking place outside of the UK. Please see the initial letter informing you of the trip for further details.
- v. The cost of participating on the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme.
- vi. The costs incurred in travelling to university interviews & open days; standard return rail fare. Please provide Mrs Piper with evidence of your ticket purchase to claim your refund.
- vii. The fees charged to sit university entrance tests. Please provide Mrs Piper with evidence of payment to claim your refund.
- viii. The fees charged to re-sit an examination. Please provide Mrs Piper with evidence of payment to claim your refund.
- ix. The cost of any other support which will enhance the student's academic progress.
